## AUDIENCE

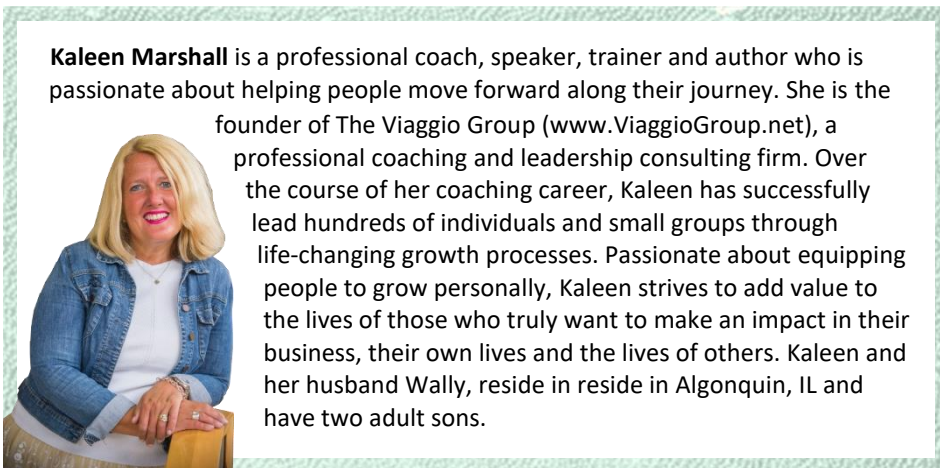

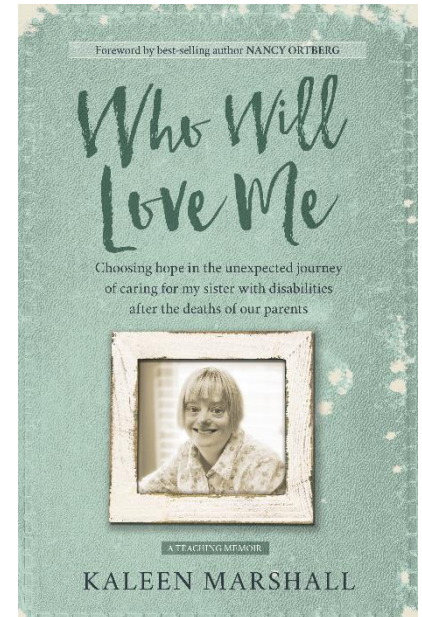
